Routine Physical Exam: Exam performed without relationship to treatment or diagnosis for a specific illness, symptom, complaint, or injury. Medicare does not cover the Routine Physical; it is prohibited by statute, however some elements of a Routine

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Physical are covered by the IPPE, the AWW, or other Medicare benefits; Patient pays 100% out-of ...
